**1. Apologies**

RESOLVED to receive apologies from Councillor C. Osler and Councillor G. Small.

**2. Declarations of interest**

**RESOLVED** to declarations of any personal or prejudicial interest in matters under consideration on this agenda as follows:

**4. Minutes**

**RESOLVED** to confirm the minutes of the meeting held on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> November 2009 and to receive reports on any matters arising, which were not included elsewhere on the agenda.

**RESOLVED** that the Locum Clerk would confirm to Cllr. Small that they would still like the donation of £750 towards the Kilkenny House Project and asked for him to arrange to transfer the money.

**RESOLVED** to note that Councillor Wylie would be meeting with Carole McMillan to discuss the allotments soon.

5. **Grants and Projects.**

**RESOLVED** that:

- Dog bins – that further consideration be given to this when the Council had heard back from the resident who had asked for additional bins in the park that separates the two sides of Tattenhoe and the Parish Warden consulted. The Locum Clerk had already contacted the resident asking for locations. Members agreed that bins could be installed if the Park Warden felt they were necessary but the final decision would be deferred until the next meeting
- Tattenhoe Parent and Toddler Group – that £800 be given to the Tattenhoe Parent and Toddler Group for one year and that they be invited to apply again for any further funding towards their running costs for the following year
- Book Voucher for Children’s’ Competitions - that a £20 be purchased for each edition of the Community News young persons’ competition
- Puddles Pre-School that a grant application be sent to the pre-school
- Brookfield Rangers Griffins Football Club – that the Parish Council order the kit and tracksuit type tops to a maximum of £750 on behalf of the club. All kit and tops to have the Parish Council logo on too. The Locum Clerk would obtain the information on sizing etc before obtaining three quotes and placing an order.

6. **Playground Safety Course**

**RESOLVED** that Members noted that it was agreed that Mark Webber, Community Warden attend a Playground Safety Course, run by the SLCC in September 2009 and that unfortunately due to illness he did not attend and his place not cancelled, therefore the Parish Council forfeited the £40 fee.

**FURTHER RESOLVED** that Mark Webber attend the Playground Safety Course on the 15<sup>th</sup> April 2010 at Denmead, Hants at a cost of £40.
