### **1. Election of a Chairman** (D Livingstone took the Chair)

N Warden was elected Chairman and took the Chair for the remainder of the meeting.

### **4. Minutes**

Minutes of the meeting of 18 May 2009 were agreed and signed as a true record of the meeting.

### **5. Grants & projects**

#### Grant Applications

The grant application from Tattenhoe FC was deferred to full council as the applicant had not received confirmation of the meeting.

#### Litter & Dog Waste Bins

The meeting considered a (circulated) report on bins and noted the cost of installation and servicing of these against the allocated budget. It was resolved to install 6 litter bins and 1 dog waste bins at locations from the list to be confirmed by the clerk.

#### Neighbourhood Action Groups

D Livingstone reported on a multi-agency meeting regarding antisocial behaviour around Furzton Pavilion and Edison Square, which will hopefully result in greater action by police and community wardens.

N Warden reported that the Emerson Valley and Tattenhoe groups have agreed to merge and the enlarged NAG will meet on 16 June. Concerns about Tattenhoe Leisure Facility will be a priority and it was agreed to try to set up a multi-agency meeting similar to that for Furzton.

**6. Staff Reports**

The youth team and warden reports were noted and approved. There was concern that no action has been taken on additional staff requirements and the youth team is required to submit a list of volunteers with a schedule for training and transfer to permanent status.

**7. Correspondence**

The meeting noted copy correspondence from Cllr C Williams regarding development of a facility at Maudsley Close, Shenley Lodge and it was agreed this was a project in which council could be involved. D Livingstone volunteered to attend any site meetings as an observer if the project is developed.
