<p>1. Apologies and declarations of Interest</p> <p>Apologies were received and accepted from C. Williams, J. Nicholas, I Stewart and G Small.</p> <p>2. Declarations of Interest</p> <p>There were no declarations of interest.</p> <p>3. Public Time</p> <p>There were no items raised.</p> <p>4. Minutes</p> <p>Minutes of the meeting on 22nd March 2010 were agreed and signed as true a record of the meeting subject to the following corrections:</p> <p>Page 1 - Public Time should read “the two tenants had been served with an eviction notice from the Windmill Hill allotments.</p> <p>Page 3 – Community Committee should read Councillor Williams reported that the Council had given out two grants.</p> <p>Matters arising</p> <p>Cllr D Livingstone informed members that the final draft of the Parish Charter had been completed by the Working Party and distributed to all members and informed members that Milton Keynes Council had circulated their own Charter.</p>	

<p>Cllr M Walton informed she attended the Young Enterprise Awards and praised the young people for all their efforts.</p> <p>5. Reports</p> <p>In the absence of the Clerk there was no report.</p> <p>The Police were not in attendance. It was suggested that in the absence of police attendance due to work commitments that we could receive a report via email. It was agreed that Cllr D Livingstone would contact Inspector Nicholls to discuss.</p> <p><u>Planning & Environment Committee</u></p> <p>Other than the various planning applications to be considered there was nothing to report.</p> <p><u>Community Committee</u></p> <p>D Edmonds informed members that he considered the meeting has been very positive with several grants being awarded in the community.</p> <p>Members had shown great enthusiasm with regard to the possible Twinning with Biot. It was felt that the parish could build relationships with a French Town supported and funded by the EU possibly up to £20k. It was agreed that this would need to go to full council for approval to move forward. The objective is to have the scheme up and running by July 2010.</p> <p>It was proposed and agreed unanimously to find out all the details involved, meet and move forward as soon as possible because it will be of great benefit to all groups in the community including schools and youth organisations.</p> <p>6. Finance</p> <p>a) The report of expenditure against budget to end March was noted and approved.</p> <p>b) The monthly finance report was circulated and the meeting adjourned while members considered this. The retrospective approval list was approved and the finance report was then approved and signed by the Chairman. It was resolved to authorise the payments listed on the appendix to these minutes.</p> <p>7. Cost of adverts in the Community News</p> <p>It was proposed to reduce our advertising rates by 50%. 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Cllr K Thomas is looking at the possibility of producing a business card size and will gauge the demand from local businesses.

It was proposed to consider the possibility of changing the distributors for our next Newsletter. Cllr N Leonards had been given details of a Company who can guarantee 100% delivery rate although the delivery charges are somewhat higher. It was agreed to try the new distributors and monitor to check if they have achieved 100% delivery rate. Prior to engagement of their services, members agreed that references would need to be checked.
