PE/36/10 **Terms of Reference– Report No PE/07/10**
The Committee **agreed** to accept the draft Terms of Reference but agreed that the implementation should be deferred for ratification until the new incoming committee is on board.

PE/37/10 **Allotments Report**
The Committee noted the allotments report and asked for confirmation that people on the waiting list for Furzton are being offered plots at other allotment sites. The report shows there is a considerable wait for both Furzton sites. The Deputy Clerk confirmed that, in date order, people are offered an alternative site but normally prefer to wait for the site nearest to their place of residence.

Members asked for an update with regard to the mound at Wimborne Crescent. The Deputy Clerk informed members that we are still waiting for Community Payback to visit the site. The Deputy Clerk informed members that the Parish Warden had discussed this issue with the Oakhill Secure Training Centre staff who would possibly be prepared to do this work. The normal procedure would be for two members of staff to be allocated to one youth, in addition there would always be a supervisor present. Members **agreed** that officers should investigate this further and if possible to arrange for the work to be completed without further delay.

PE/38/10 **Allotment Draft Terms & Conditions – Report No PE/08/10**
Members reviewed the draft which included changes suggested by the National Society of Allotment & Leisure Gardeners (NSALG) together with their 'Guidelines for Keeping Hens on Allotments' The changes were accepted and it was agreed that their Guidelines should be referenced in the new T&C as representing 'best practice'. Additional comments were made by members and it was agreed that these should be included in the final draft to be taken to Council.
